♪ Membership in the Chancel Choir is required.

All Confirmed in the Catholic Faith or Confirmation students who have leadership skills in singing are encouraged to be part of this awesome group of volunteer cantors. Students will receive community service hours. The cantors are scheduled for the three English Masses on a rotation that fits their schedules. Usually, a cantor will be scheduled for 2-3 Masses per month and are also needed for Christmas, Holy Week, Mass of Remembrance, and bilingual Holy Days. Cantors are needed and compensated for singing at weddings and funerals.

Cantors also help the cantors in training. All cantors will receive music plans for Mass and any assistance needed to prepare properly. No music reading skills are required, but are helpful. You will receive all the training needed.
